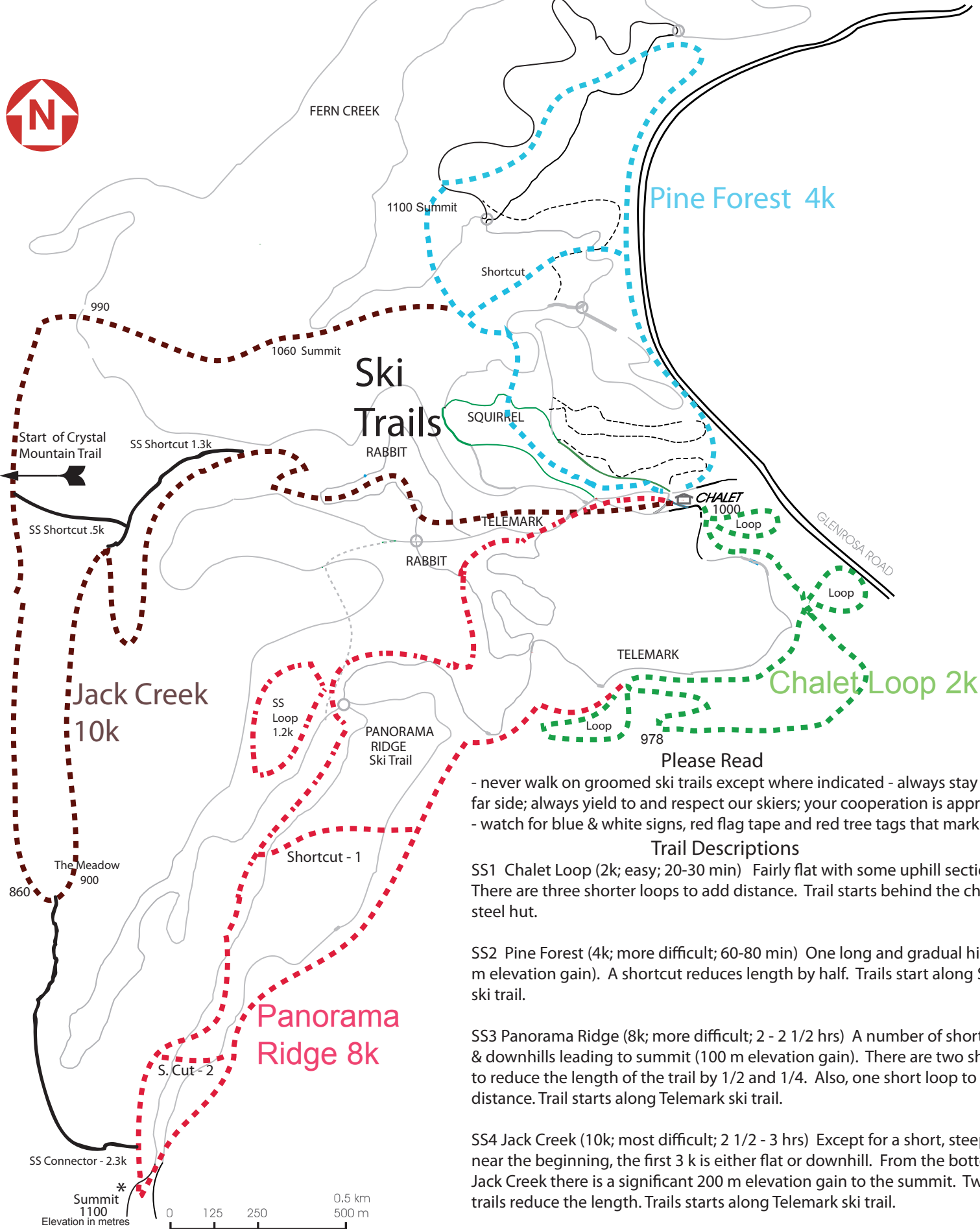


Snowshoe Map

Telemark Chalet 250 768 1494



Please Read
- never walk on groomed ski trails except where indicated - always stay to the far side; always yield to and respect our skiers; your cooperation is appreciated
- watch for blue & white signs, red flag tape and red tree tags that mark trails

Trail Descriptions
SS1 Chalet Loop (2k; easy; 20-30 min) Fairly flat with some uphill sections. There are three shorter loops to add distance. Trail starts behind the chalet by steel hut.

SS2 Pine Forest (4k; more difficult; 60-80 min) One long and gradual hill (100 m elevation gain). A shortcut reduces length by half. Trails start along Squirrel ski trail.

SS3 Panorama Ridge (8k; more difficult; 2 - 2 1/2 hrs) A number of short uphill & downhills leading to summit (100 m elevation gain). There are two shortcuts to reduce the length of the trail by 1/2 and 1/4. Also, one short loop to add distance. Trail starts along Telemark ski trail.

SS4 Jack Creek (10k; most difficult; 2 1/2 - 3 hrs) Except for a short, steep hill near the beginning, the first 3 k is either flat or downhill. From the bottom of Jack Creek there is a significant 200 m elevation gain to the summit. Two side trails reduce the length. Trails starts along Telemark ski trail.

SS5 Crystal Mountain (13k; most difficult; 3-4 hours) Obtain map from office.
